## **ACT/SAT TEST DATES**

The ACT or SAT are tests required for those students planning on attending college. It is recommended that a student take both the SAT and ACT during the junior year. Also, it is recommended that a student take one of the admission tests twice. When retaking a test, the colleges will take the highest score; therefore, you can never score lower, only higher. If you have any questions about taking the ACT or SAT test, contact Miss Julius. Remember the tests are on Saturdays, so the student must be aware of conflicts with sporting events, vacations, etc. Applications for both tests are available in the attendance/guidance office, or the student may register online at <a href="www.collegeboard.com">www.collegeboard.com</a> (SAT) or <a href="www.act.org">www.act.org</a> (ACT). The school code number is <a href="151985">151985</a>. It is important to mark the school code (<a href="151985">151985</a>) on your application so Lapel High School receives your scores.

Any student who is registering with the NCAA should mark the NCAA Clearinghouse (<u>9999</u>) to receive your scores. The school is no longer able to send the scores on your transcript. The scores must come directly from the ACT or SAT office.

Many of the colleges are requiring the scores come directly from the ACT or SAT office. The student can mark 4 different colleges or programs to receive your scores.

When registering for the SAT, you are registering for the SAT Reasoning Test (\$50.00).
